You will never know how grateful my wife and I are to you excellent young people. You have thorough knowledge of how to stabilize and basically salvage a live almost lost. Twice my lungs spasmed – both times in the boat and both times your professional skills and knowledge pulled me back from disaster. Regretfully 2 medications I take is responsible – was for that problem. Carucdilol has been a culprit for months and we did not know it. It caused shortness of breath and in the conditions of the boat on cool mornings caused a shutdown of my lung function. I've stopped the 25 mg daily and I feel like I've gained 20 years of youth back. Sure wish I could have figured it out without all the stress on me, my wife and you.

I am forever grateful that you excellent young people were so skilled in assisting me in a very traumatic time.
