#### Resolution 2016-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #21 ADOPTING THE TAX REVENUES AND BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 2017

**WHEREAS,** the County Assessor for Whatcom County has advised the Board of Fire Commissioners of Whatcom County Fire Protection District No. 21 that the assessed value of real properties lying within the boundaries of said District have been certified; and,

WHEREAS, Title 84.52.020 of the Revised Code of Washington requires that the District must certify to the county legislative authority for the purpose of levying District taxes, budgets or the estimates of the amount to be raised by taxation; and,

WHEREAS, the assessed valuation of real properties lying within the boundaries of said District for the calendar year 2016 before any exemptions is certified to be \$3,924,565,896 and,

WHEREAS, the assessed valuation of real properties lying within the boundaries of said District to be used for the actual calculation of the levy for 2017 for the calendar year 2016 is \$3,924,565,896; and,

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that

- 1. The attached hereto Exhibit "A" (by this reference made a part of this resolution) be, and hereby is adopted as the budget of Whatcom County Fire Protection District No. 21 for the calendar year 2017,
- 2. That the Honorable County Council of Whatcom County, Washington, be and are hereby requested to make a levy for 2017 for said Whatcom County Fire Protection District No. 21 in the amount of \$5,692,000.
- 3. That the County Treasurer of Whatcom County, Washington, be and is hereby authorized and directed to deposit and sequester the monies received from the collection of the tax levy specified in Section 2 above in the amounts and funds specified below:
